

## LIFELONG LEARNING calls 2012

### About Lifelong Learning programme

As the flagship European Funding programme in the field of education and training, the Lifelong Learning Programme (LLP) enables individuals at all stages of their lives to pursue stimulating learning opportunities across Europe. It is an umbrella programme integrating various educational and training initiatives. LLP is divided in four sectorial sub programmes and four so called 'transversal' programmes.

The sectorial sub programmes focus on different stages of education and training and continuing previous programmes:

- [Erasmus](#) for higher education
  - 2.1 Mobility
    - Erasmus Intensive Programmes (IP)
    - An Intensive Programme (IP) is a short programme of study which brings together students and teaching staff from higher education institutions of at least three participating countries. In addition to the learning outcomes on subject-related competences, IPs should favour the transmission of transversal competences, and the workload of participating students should be recognised through the ECTS (or otherwise equivalent) credits.
    - Erasmus Intensive Language Courses (EILC)
    - These courses are a key element for the development of the linguistic and intercultural competencies of mobile students and for the promotion of multilingualism in Europe.

#### What grant is available?

- 200.000 € per year. However, maximum EU contribution to projects will be 400.000 €
- The maximum grant for all third country partners combined is 25.000 € in addition to the amount specified above
- The maximum EU contribution is 75%.

#### What grant is available?

- A maximum EU contribution to projects will be 600.000 € for the entire duration of the project.
- The maximum grant for all third country partners combined is 25.000 € in addition to the amount specified above
- The maximum EU contribution is 75%.

The transversal programmes aim to complement the sectorial sub programmes and to ensure that they achieve the best results possible. They aim to promote European cooperation in fields covering two or more of the sub-programmes. In addition they seek to promote quality and transparency of Member States' education and training systems.

The [Jean Monnet programme](#) also falls under the LLP umbrella, in addition to the sectorial and transversal programmes, The Jean Monnet programme stimulates teaching, reflection and debate on the European integration process at higher education institutions.

## Budget

LLP has a budget of nearly €7 billion for the period 2007 to 2013.
